Médecins Sans Frontières is the world's leading independent organisation for medical humanitarian aid. Every day, more than 24,000 Médecins Sans Frontières field staff provide assistance to people caught in crises around the world. Every year, over one hundred Australians and New Zealanders are sent to the field and supported by Médecins Sans Frontières Australia Ltd.

Our teams are working in over 60 countries in some of the most challenging settings and situations. No matter where they work their goal is the same: to provide essential medical-humanitarian aid to those who need it most, regardless of race, religion, gender or political affiliation.

We provide medical and relief aid after natural disasters such as cyclones, floods or earthquakes. We help victims of conflict. We run emergency feeding programs during nutritional crises. We tackle neglected diseases such as malaria, HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis and Kala Azar; and we organise mass vaccination programs to prevent epidemics spreading.

Our teams witness the result of conflict, neglect and disaster which often escapes broader international attention. We are committed to speaking out about these crises to alert the public to the plight of the people we help, to alleviate their suffering, protect life and health and to restore respect for fundamental human rights.
